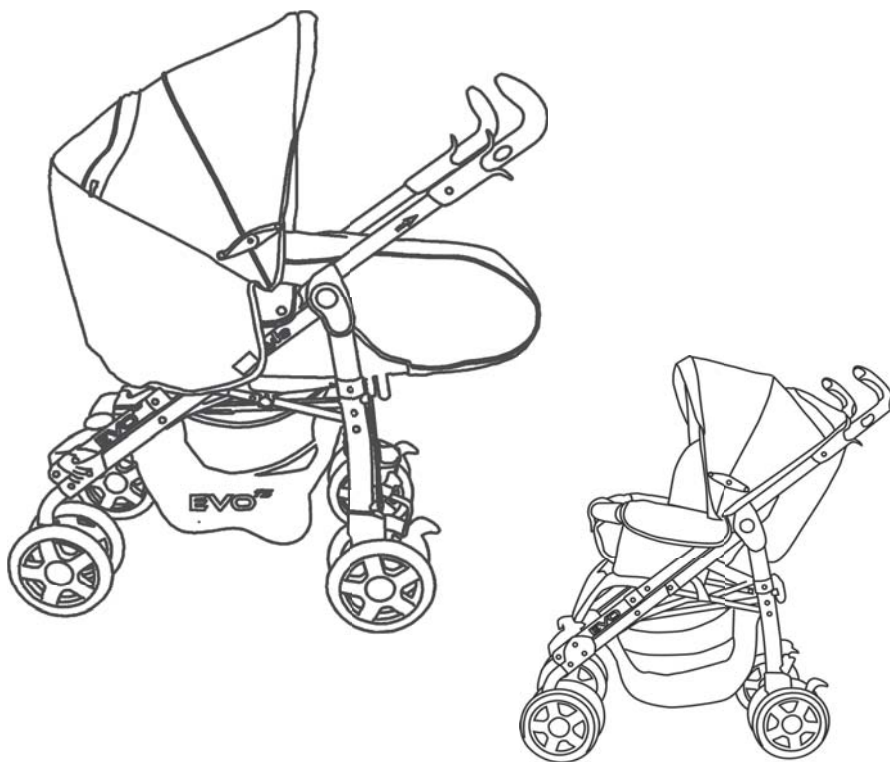


# EVO<sup>TS</sup>



## Babystyle EVO Newborn Comfort Pack (From Birth Pack)

### Instruction manual

**IMPORTANT:** Read these instructions carefully before use and keep for future reference. Your child's safety may be affected if you do not follow these instructions.

The Newborn Comfort Pack has been designed for use with the Babystyle EVO and should not be used with any other product. The comfort pack creates a 'lay-flat' environment for your child from birth up to 9kg.

## **Safety Advice and Warnings**

**IMPORTANT** – Please read these instructions carefully before using your new product. Keep this manual in a safe place for future reference. This product complies with British Standard BS 7409: 1996.

### **Important Safety Information**

- **WARNING:** A child's safety is your responsibility
- **WARNING:** Children should never be left unattended in this vehicle.
- It is important that any person intending to use this vehicle fully understands the instructions.
- **WARNING:** Children should be harnessed in this vehicle at all times. Use the five point harness that is provided, make sure the harness is securely fastened. Adjust the harness to its correct position with the use of the adjustable buckles & straps.
- D - rings to attach a separate harness can be found attached to the integral harness either side of the seat unit.
- **WARNING:** Children should always be kept clear of moving parts while making adjustments to the vehicle.
- Never overload the vehicle. **The maximum weight of child in the Newborn Comfort Pack (carry cot liner) should not exceed 9kg**
- The maximum weight for the child in the pushchair should not exceed 15kg
  - The weight limit for the shopping tray is 3 kg. Always place articles in the centre of the tray provided. Any load attached to the handle will adversely affect the stability of the vehicle.
- **WARNING:** Incorrect assembly, folding or use of this vehicle may cause damage and affect the safety of the vehicle.
- It may be unsafe to use accessories (e.g. child seats, bag hooks, rain covers etc.) other than those approved by the manufacturer.
- **WARNING:** Never leave the vehicle without first engaging the parking device.
- Avoid uphill or downhill parking.
- Avoid using the vehicle on steps, stairs or escalators as it may be dangerous to your child/children.
- Check on a regular basis to make sure that all essential components & locking devices are functioning correctly.
- Do not use replacement parts other than those supplied by the manufacturer or distributor.
- Do not use this vehicle as a permanent bed for your child / children.

Children should be harnessed in at all times and should never be left unattended. The child should be clear of moving parts while making adjustments. This vehicle requires regular maintenance by the user. Overloading, incorrect folding and the use of non-approved accessories may damage or break this vehicle. Read the manufacturer's instructions.

Open the pack and check the contents, you should have the following:

- 1 x Instruction manual**
  - 2 x Flexible side panels**
  - 1 x Fabric liner**
  - 1 x Wedge shaped mattress**

**Fitting Instructions**

**1,** Insert the flexible side panels.

The side panels are different lengths, the longest one is inserted into the foot end and the shortest one is inserted into the head end.

Locate the side zippers on the liner and insert the side panels into the zipper opening of the liner. The rounded edges of each side panel should be pointing down towards the base of the liner. The side panel ends (foot end and head end) should meet at the zipper opening when both panels are inserted.

**2,** On the EVO pushchair remove the hood by pushing in the clip on the rear outside of the armrest

**3,** Recline the EVO seat backrest to its 1<sup>st</sup> (from fully upright) reclined position.

**4,** Lift up the Evo leg-rest so that it touches the bumper bar.

**5,** Place the liner in the EVO so that the head end (quilted end) is closest to the bumper bar and fold the elasticated liner fabric over the bumper bar and the footrest. Attach the Velcro on the liner to the underneath of the seat.

**6,** At the foot end fold the elasticated liner fabric over the partially reclined seat backrest. When the foot-end of the liner is folded over the backrest, recline the seat backrest to the fully reclined position. Check the sides of the liner are sitting on the base of the seat and back rest.

**7,** Thread the D-rings (found on the waist belts of the Evo harness) through the openings on the base of the liner. The D-rings are anchorage points for an independent harness.

**8,** Attach the hood so that the hood opening faces the handles of the EVO, secure the rear of the hood underneath the liner with the hooks.

**9,** The apron can be fitted over the foot end of the liner and the press-studs on the apron top can be attached to the corresponding press-studs inside the hood. Secure the apron underneath the liner using the hooks.

### **Washing and Care Instructions:**

#### **Fabric liner:**

Remove the mattress and the plastic boards before washing

Hand wash only

Dry flat

#### **Side support boards:**

Sponge clean with mild detergent

#### **Mattress:**

Do not tumble dry

Turn mattress and air regularly

Do not use Biological detergents

Do not iron or expose to heat

The mattress cover may be sponge cleaned with warm water

Ensure mattress is completely dry before use

### **WARRANTY**

Babystyle UK Limited provides a warranty in support of the retailer from whom you purchased this product. The warranty is effective for 6 months from the date of purchase for the original purchaser/owner. Proof of purchase will (at the discretion of Babystyle UK Limited) be required in order for your retailer to claim on the warranty. The warranty excludes any fault caused by misuse, damage or neglect. It is the user's responsibility to undertake routine inspection and maintenance of the vehicle in order to avoid damage to the vehicle and/or injury to the child. The vehicle is returned to the retailer at the owner's expense in order to ascertain if a claim under warranty is justified. Please read the instructions carefully, they will help you to look after your stroller and ensure correct safe use.
